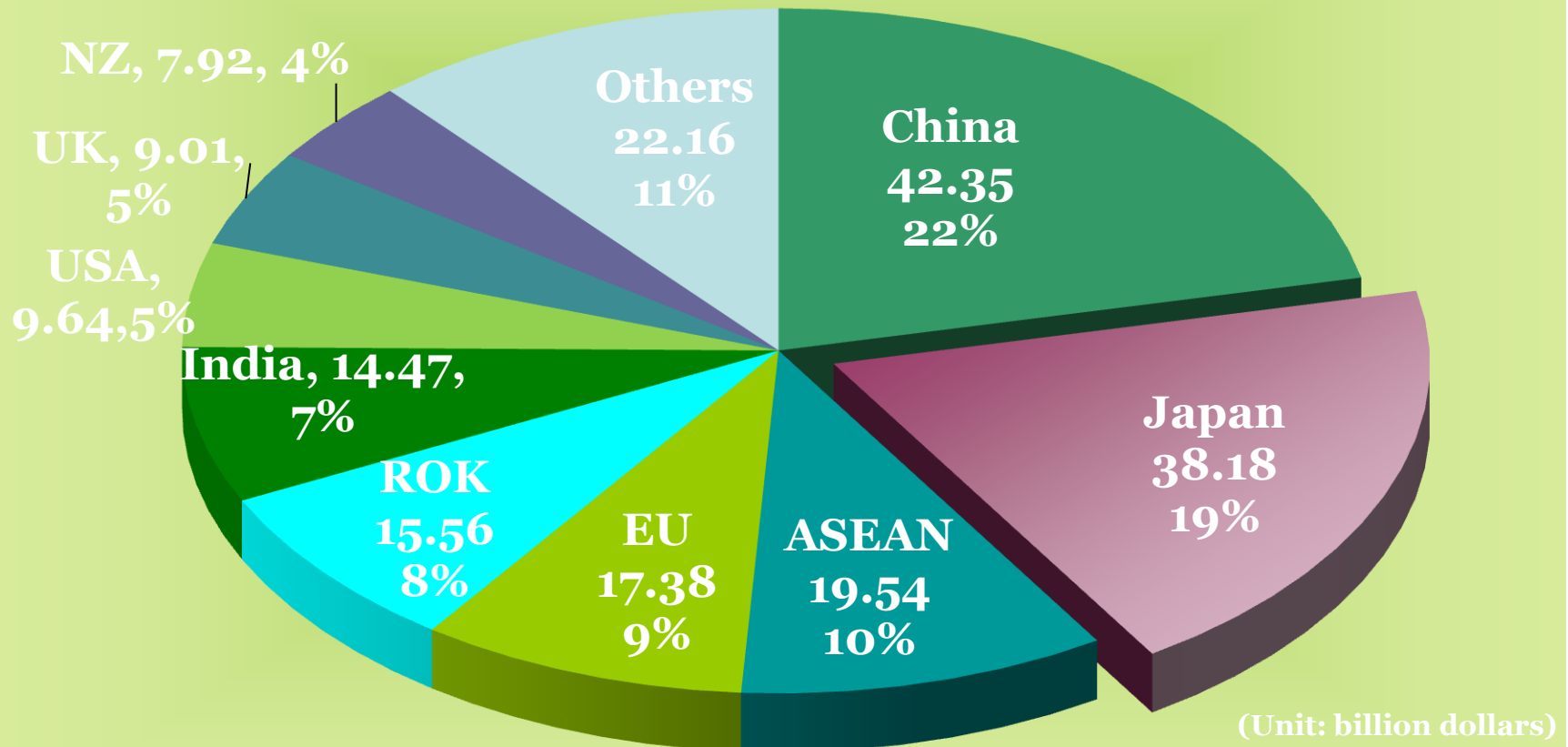

by Countries and Country Groups (2009)*



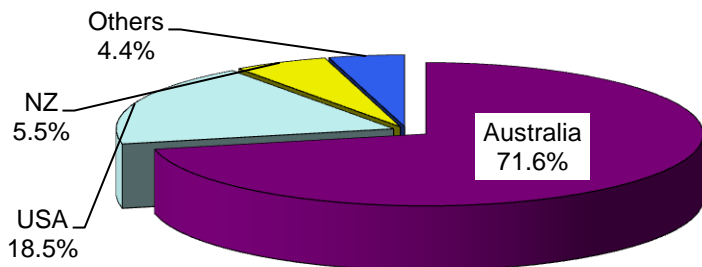

## Japanese imports of major commodities by country

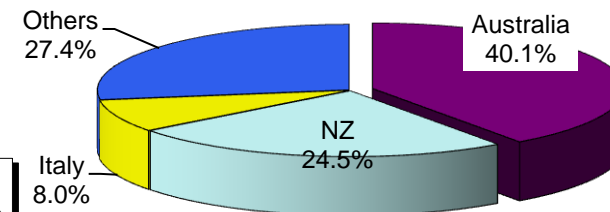

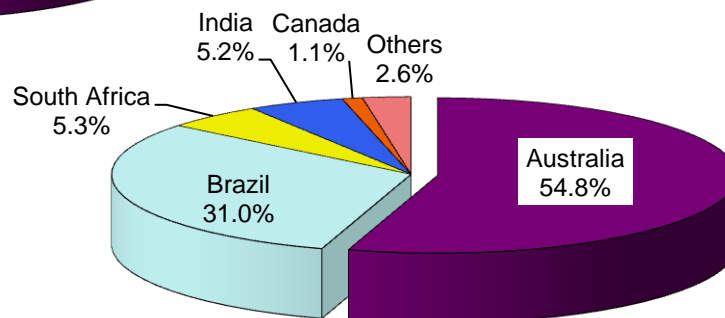
### NATURAL CHEESE (2009)

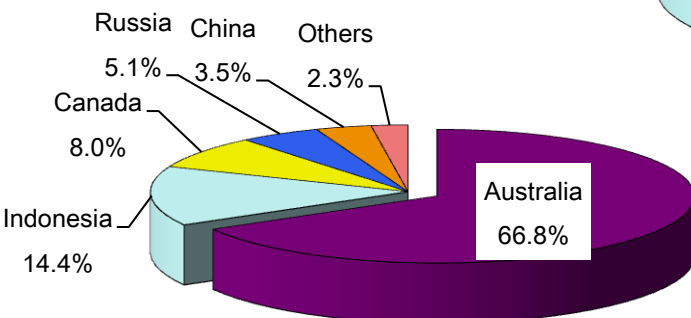
### IRON ORES (2009)

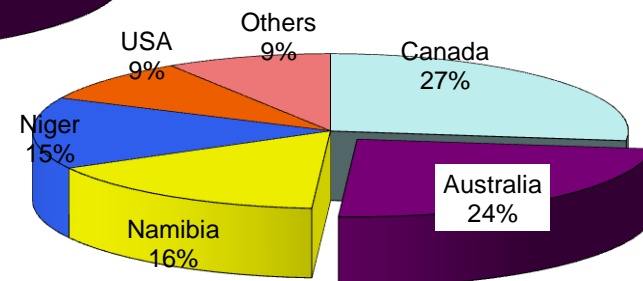
### COAL(2009)

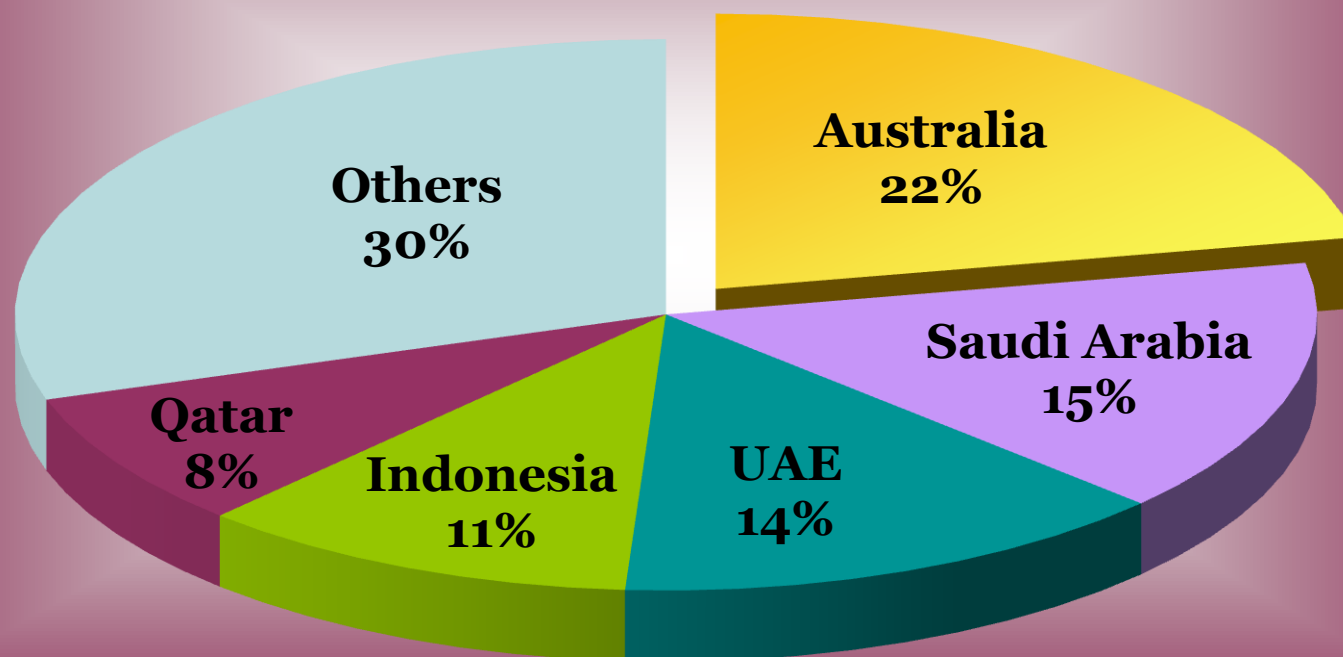

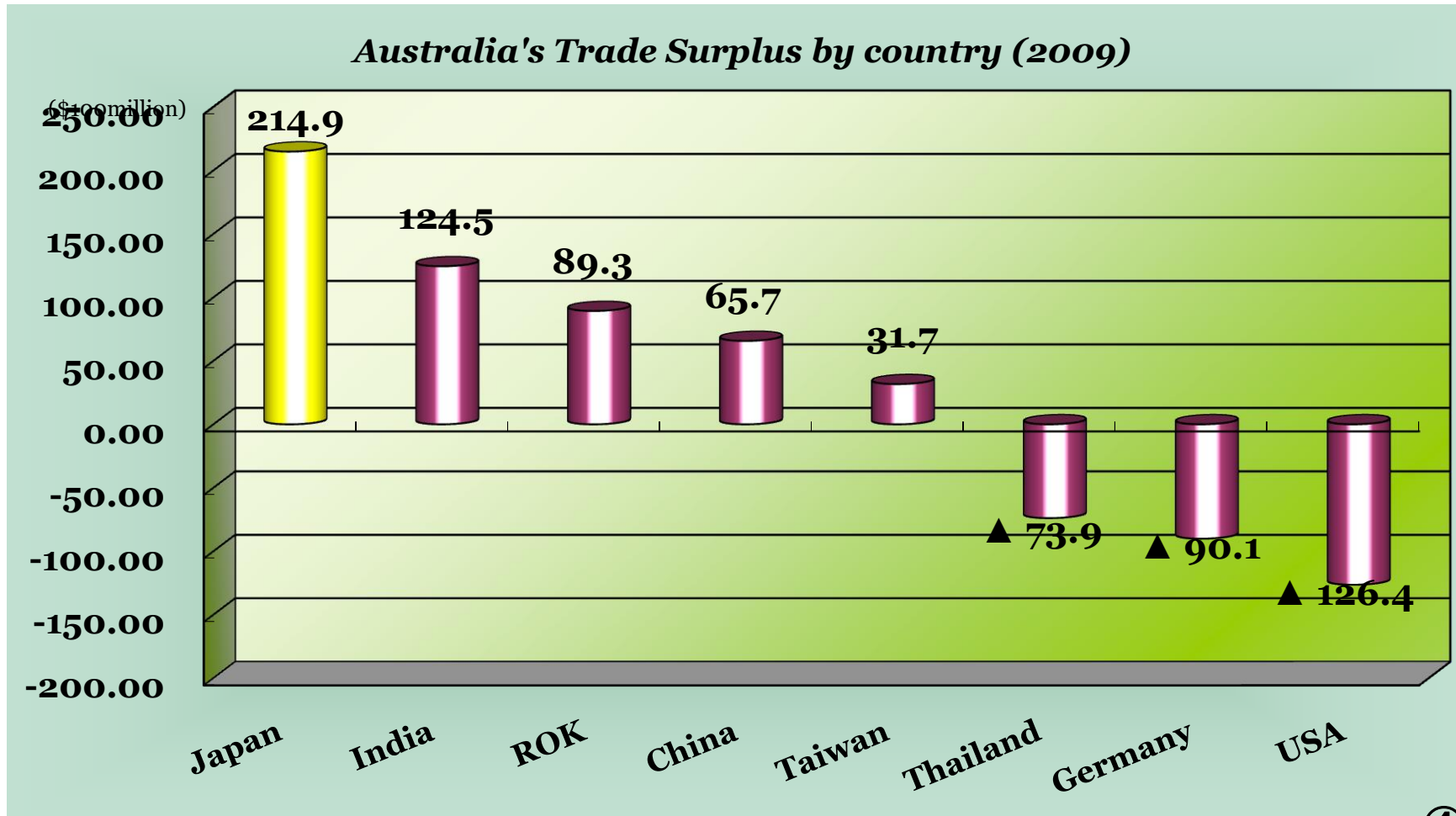
*Total Import of Petroleum, LNG and Coal by Country

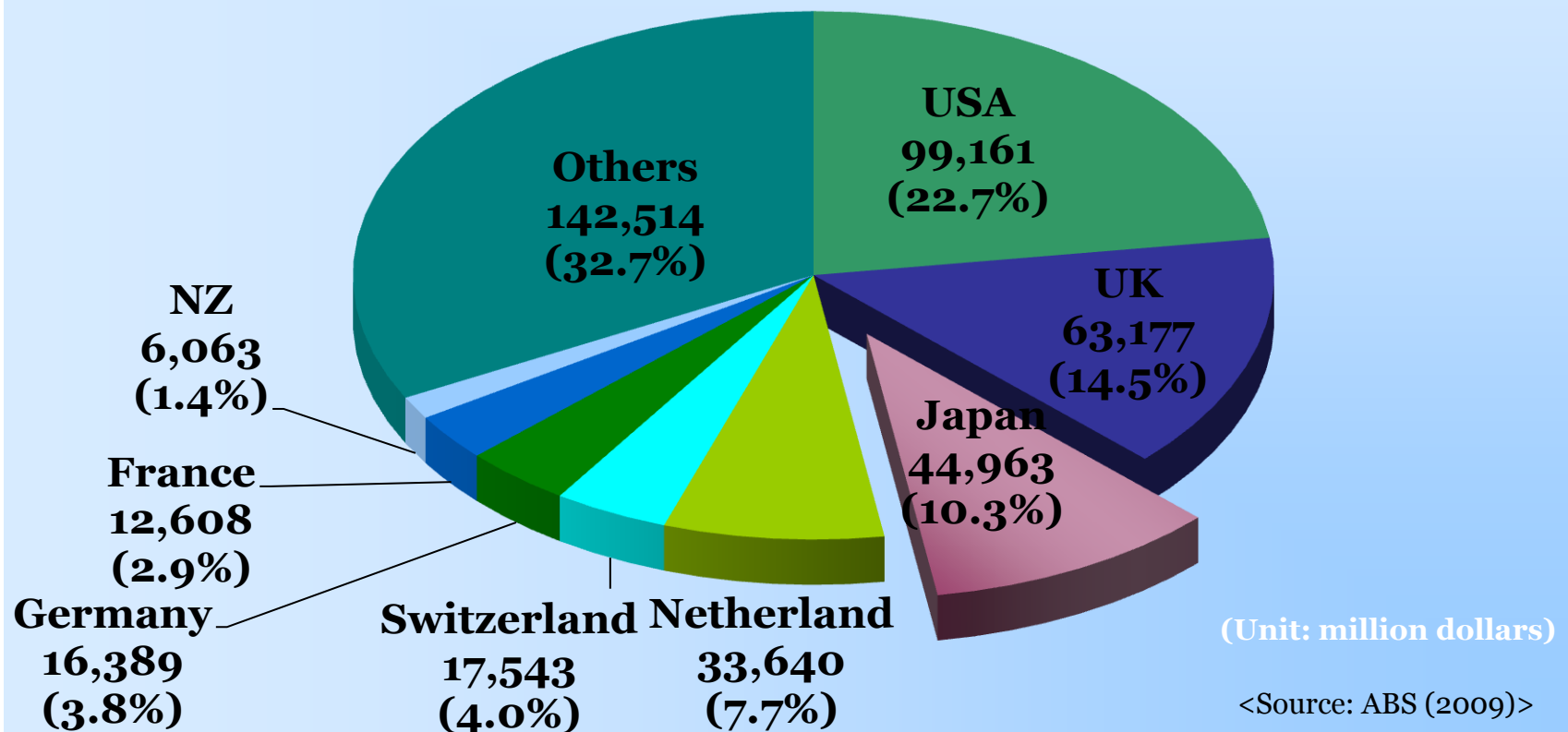
# Australia's trade surplus with Japan is larger than any other country.

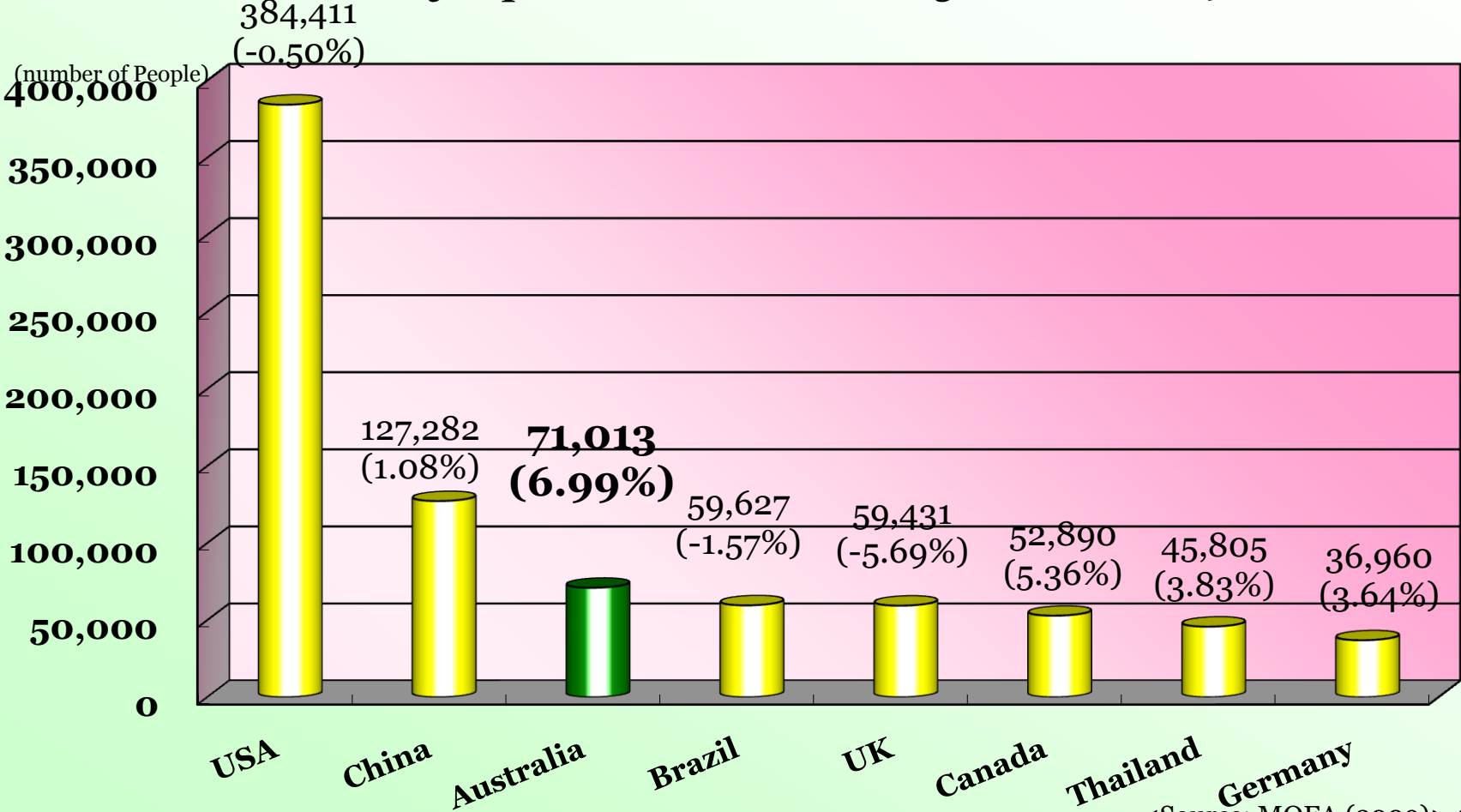
# Japanese are major investors to Australia.

# Australia hosts the third largest number of Japanese residents.

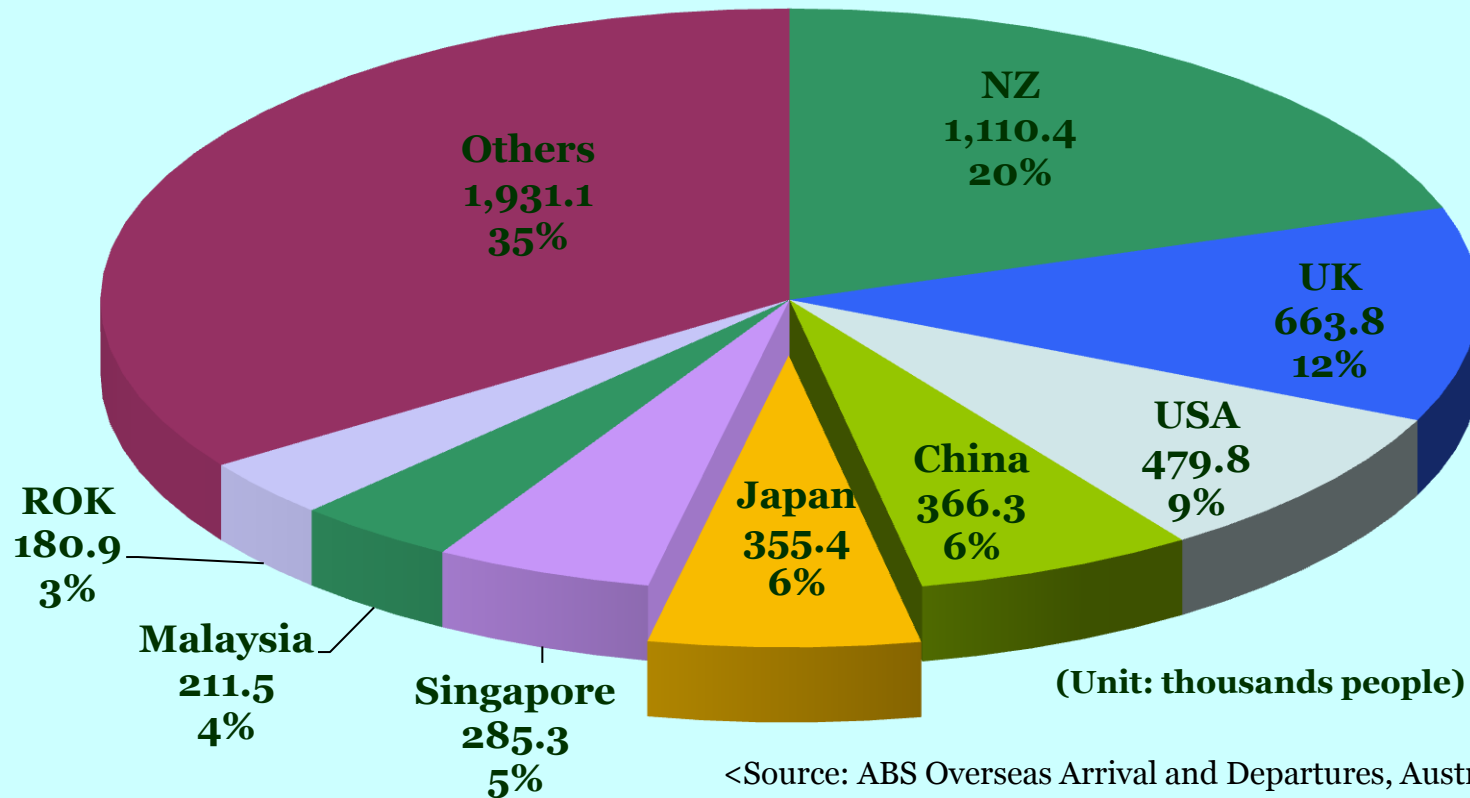
Number of Japanese citizens residing abroad (2009)

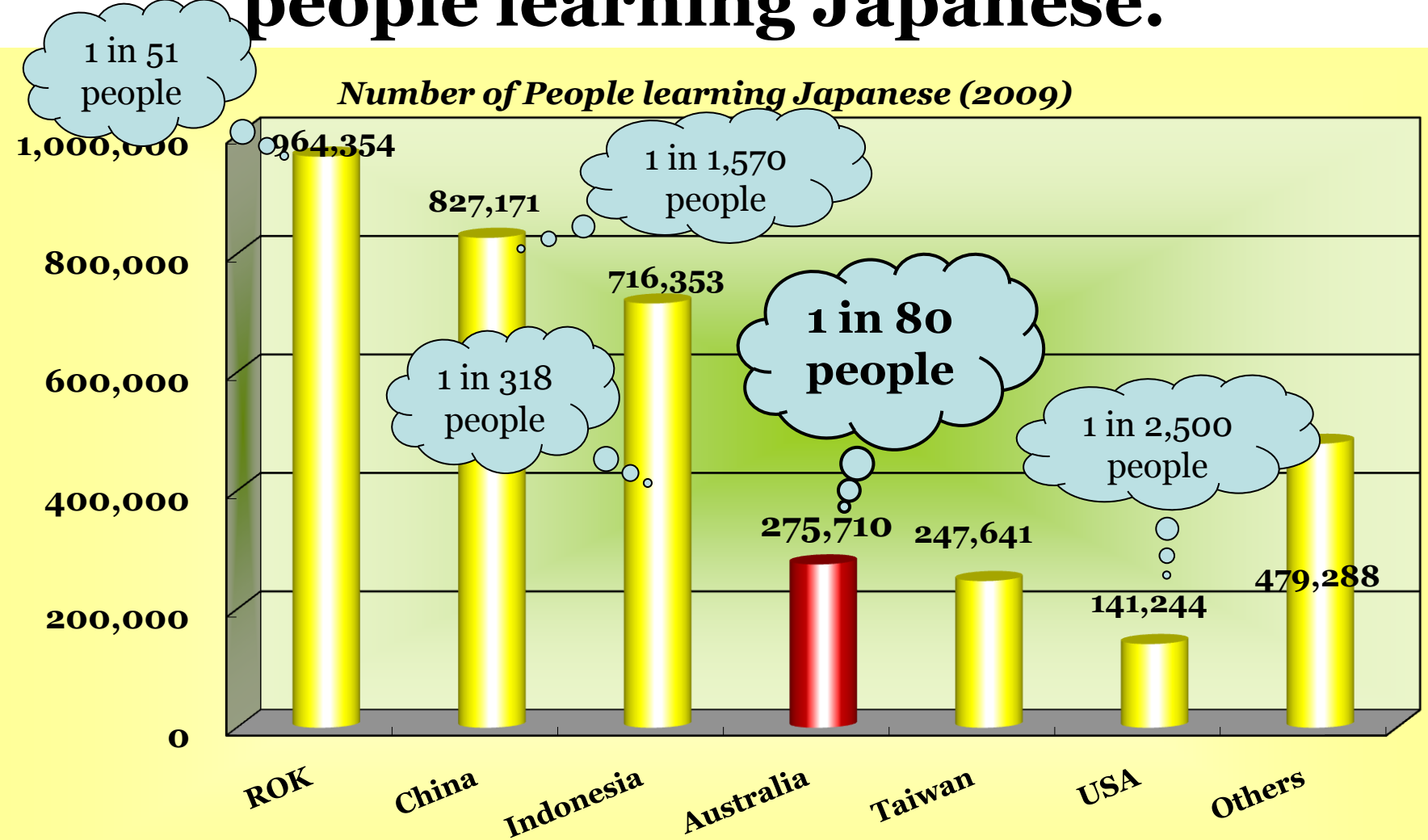
# Japan ranks fifth in visitor arrivals in Australia.
