- The application form must be typed and two (2) sets must be printed out and submitted. In order for them to be considered originals, they <u>must both be signed by the candidate</u> (no electronic/digital signatures).
- 3. The recommendation letter must be printed on your school's letterhead and physically signed by the recommender (no electronic/digital signatures).
- 4. Applicants must sit Japanese and English exams and must demonstrate enough proficiency in the Japanese language to pass the initial screening.
- The examinations will be held on <u>Friday 4th March 2022 (TBC)</u> at the Embassy of Japan in Canberra and the Consulates-General of Japan in Sydney, Melbourne, Perth and Brisbane. Please note that the examination may be conducted in various cities in Australia, <u>but not</u> <u>overseas</u>.
- 6. Please submit the **Exam Locations Form** to indicate where you will sit the exams if you proceed to the next stage.
- 7. Please include your mobile phone number in your application.
- 8. Copies of official documents <u>must be certified</u> by a Justice of Peace (JP) or a person who is authorised to certify documents in Australia before being submitted to the Embassy.
